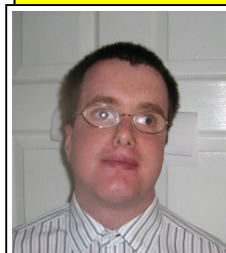
SoLO held a ball for its members which was run by SURG. It was a great night with lovely food, music and dance. Everyone said it was a great night and it has been in the local papers.
